Receipt of yet further non-compliance with the New York State Freedom of Information Law (FOIL) is acknowledged and received on Saturday, June 2, 2007.


Please be advised that the law requires the release of actual documents that support the information sought. It does not allow for the "creation" of information that is normally maintained in the course of everyday business. Upon information and belief, much of what has been requested is available in a medium that makes it readily available to be e-mailed and/or put onto a CD or DVD medium.

The school district's actions, to date, serve to underpin a negative attitude towards the requested release of the previously requested documents. Incidentally, I have previously spoke with, communicated with Robert Nole, his secretary via e-mails and my requests for pertinent school documents were followed with a letter indicating that that could not be released for some thirty (30) days. This time has long since passed and further tactics used to deny me the requested documents will undermine your credibility as a public official vis-à-vis your role as Records Access Officer.

Please be advised that you are in violation of the FOIL law and should the requested documents not be received by June 12, 2007; it is my intention of putting this matter before the public and litigated in the appropriate forum.

I trust you will endeavor to comply with the FOIL law not violate it!
