Hi Lorey- As you may know, the New Hartford Public Library has petitioned the School District to become a School District Library. There will be a Vote on the issue August 23, 2012. If it and the proposed budget passes, the funding for the Library will no longer be in the Town Budget- rather a special line item (Not part of the School Budget). The budget then stays the same unless the Library Board goes back to the Residents for an increase and it is approved. This rechartering will give stability of funding to the Library instead of leaving it up to the Town Supervisor every year. The School District as well as the Town Board support the rechartering. The Library would like to do an informational mailing to PTA members. Do you have a list from all the NH Schools that you can share for this purpose? Please let me know and Thanks.
