Please be advised that this FOIL request is made on behalf of Concerned Citizens For Honest and Open Government and that the documents sought will be made available for public viewing to the residents of the Town of New Hartford and School District residents via their web site: [ <http://www.nhconcernedcitizens.com/> ]. Accordingly, these documents should be made available free-of-charge because of it being in the public interest.

Additionally, the school is cognizant of the fact that the above group consists of New Hartford taxpayers whose real property tax dollars subsidize the school district's salaries and operating expenses. School district officials should be mindful of this fact when attempting to "charge" school district taxpayers for documents already paid for with hard-earned tax dollars via property tax assessments.

Lastly, any document that has been electronically produced and/or there exists multiple copies in inventory - these must be given without charge. The Committee For Open Government has made this clear in prior rulings through their Executive Director, Robert Freeman.
